During this one-hour presentation, participants will learn about the documentation and reporting requirements unique to the care of patients covered by no fault / PIP coverage, how to respond to carrier denials and IME reports, and how a recent NYS Appeals Court decision impacts carrier denials. Details of proper recording keeping and reporting will be discussed, including methods to prepare for and complete the arbitration process. A panel of chiropractors and attorneys with expertise in various aspects of No-Fault Claims will offer guidance in proper documentation, communications, and navigating unique scenarios. 




